

CHRIST THE KING SCHOOL - ENROLMENT POLICY

Application:

An Application for Enrolment at Christ the King Primary School must have:



- All details completed on the Application for Enrolment form. (Including adding your Child's Birth Certificate Details). The original should be brought to the interview to be validated.
- Catholic Baptism Certificate (plus Eucharist & Confirmation), only if applicable.
- Current School Report for children enrolling in Years 1 – 6.
- Letters/reports from Specialists or Therapists, if applicable.
- Legal documents relating to your family – e.g. Domestic Violence or Parenting Orders.
- Copies of Visas and passports, if applicable.

Priority:

When enrolling students, Christ the King School gives priority to those who are baptised Catholic. Christ the King School may also enrol students from other faith traditions whose families demonstrate that they share the expressed values of the school and who are willing to support and contribute to the school's vision and ethos.

Following the enrolment process, places are offered to –

- Siblings and baptised catholic children of families who are active members of Burpengary Parish;
- Baptised Catholic children of families residing in the Burpengary Parish;
- Baptised Catholic children of families who are members of another Parish;
- Baptised Children of other Christian faith traditions whose family's value and support the Catholic religious aspect of education;
- Children of other religious traditions whose family values and support the Catholic religious aspect of education.
- Children whose families value and support the Catholic religious aspect of education.

****Order of priority with each of these categories will be at the discretion of the Principal.***

Significant Educational Adjustments.

The enrolment of students requiring significant educational adjustments is the concern of the whole school as a community within the Church.

The Enrolment Application and Support Procedures for Students requiring Significant Educational Adjustments encourage all participants in the education process to share as partners the responsibility for successful outcomes for all students.

The partners in the educational process are parents, students, teachers, school leadership, inclusive education staff and Brisbane Catholic Education representatives. The process seeks to reveal and clarify the characteristics of the learner and to assess the adjustments for accessing the learning and the implications of these for the school, the family and the student.

Further details regarding this process are available from the school office.

Low Availability

When the number of Catholic applicants exceeds the places available in the school, the following criteria will be considered:

- Catholic Church and faith commitment (e.g. practice, sacramental program; parish involvement). Commitment to Catholic Education.
- Proximity to the school.
- Parental expectations for their children at Christ the King School.
- Student's past record of learning and behaviour.

Age Requirements

Children enrolling should meet the necessary age requirements for entry for each year level:

- Preparatory: Children must turn four by 30 June the year prior to commencing Prep. The option for early or delayed entry to Prep may be considered in specific circumstances and where it is in a child's best educational interests.
- Year 1: Children must turn five by 30 June the year prior to commencing Year 1.
- Years 2-6: Children will be placed in age-appropriate classes.

Interview

All families applying for enrolments are required for an interview with the Principal or the Assistant Principal Religious Education prior to a decision on acceptance into the school being made.

Enrolment at Christ the King School is at the discretion of the Principal.
